

Baseball Cards of the Human Body!

Directions –

1. You will be making baseball cards for the different organ systems in the human body. For this project you will need the following:
 - Note cards
 - Coloring tools; like crayons and colored pencils (avoid markers, they will bleed through the note card)
 - Notes from class
2. You will need to make one baseball card for each of the organ systems you've learned about in class.
3. Each card must contain specific information about one body system. Look at the project requirements below for the information that needs to be on each side of the baseball card.
4. The project is worth 50 points. You will be graded on:
 - The quality and neatness of your work
 - Meeting all of the project requirements

Project Requirements –

- Side One must contain the following:
 1. The name of the organ system
 - The name needs to be **clearly visible** on the card
 2. A picture that relates to the specific system
 - This picture must be hand-drawn (you are welcome to trace it as well)
 - The image may be realistic or cartoonish
 3. There should be no white space on the front of the card
 - Give it a background
 - Give it a border
- Side Two must contain the following:
 1. The organ system responsibilities
 - This should be the **main** responsibility of the organ system
 2. The main organ(s) in the system
 - Make a list
 3. Fun facts about the organ system
 - You need to have three (3) fun facts
 - These can be facts from your notes, book, or another source, but should **not** be a repeat of any information already stated on your card.
